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Dressage conditions of entry

1. All classes run under ESNZ rules.
2. Riders, horses and ponies must have current ESNZ registration and an annual start for dressage valid until 13 October 2017.
3. No prior qualification necessary for classes 21, 22, 23 but if more entries are received than places available, the Dressage NZ selectors reserve the right to select combinations and name a wait list in reserve order.
4. Class 24 - the first 6 place getters from class 23 qualify and are required to ride the following evening as part of the Friday Night Show, start time to be confirmed.
5. Class 24 - please nominate for this class at the time of entry. Those that qualify have until 7pm on Thursday 12 October to pay their entry fee.
6. Start times in the schedule are approximate, the draw will be available on Equestrian Entries. Allocated draw times must be adhered to.
7. A mounted prize giving will take place at the end of each class. The first 6 place getters are required, non-attendance will result in prize money and/or ribbons being withheld. Sashes are awarded to 6th place.
8. All tests will be ridden in the NRM & McMillan Indoor arena in a 60 x 20m arena.
9. All horses must wear two ID numbers whether competing or exercising.
10. Arena Familiarisation: Horses may walk, trot and canter in the arena
 - Prix St Georges - 10.30am
 - Inter A - 11.00am
 - Grand Prix - 11.30am
11. Class entry fees include:
 - 2 x wristbands, one for the rider and one for a groom. Wristbands enable entry into Equidays for Thursday and all three further days.
 - 2 x tickets for the Festival of Dressage
 - Each extra horse entered gets an extra wristband
12. Please note: Wristbands do not include entry to the Friday, Saturday or Sunday night shows at Equidays. Festival of Dressage tickets are required to access the grandstands at this event.
13. Extra wristbands can be purchased via Equestrian Entries when you enter.
14. Night show tickets and extra Festival of Dressage tickets may be purchased separately at www.equidays.co.nz.
15. Entries close Wednesday 20th September 2017. Please enter online at www.equestrianentries.co.nz.
16. Late entries will incur a 25% late fee and will be put on a wait list.
17. Riders are responsible for updating their contact details on Equestrian Entries. This includes email, mobile, home phone, physical address and announcer notes.
18. Incorrect or incomplete entries or fees will not be accepted.
19. Scratchings - refund for all classes and other fees less 25%. Subject to proof of inability to compete. Subject to conditions and refund form being completed within 7 days of the event. Stable and yard fees will be fully refunded up until 9 October 2017.
20. All prize money will be paid via internet banking.
21. Yards: \$35 for the duration of the event.
22. Stables: \$80 for the duration of the event.
23. Stables are limited.
24. **All stallions must be stabled when not ridden.**
25. Camping: Non-powered sites are \$30. Powered sites are \$80 for duration of the event. These prices are per site, not per person.
26. Equidays reserves the right to alter, delete or amend any class as it sees fit.
27. Mystery Creek Events Centre takes no responsibility for injury or loss to competitor, horse or gear.
28. No dogs allowed on Mystery Creek Events Centre property at any time, any dogs will result in disqualification.
29. No motorbikes allowed.
